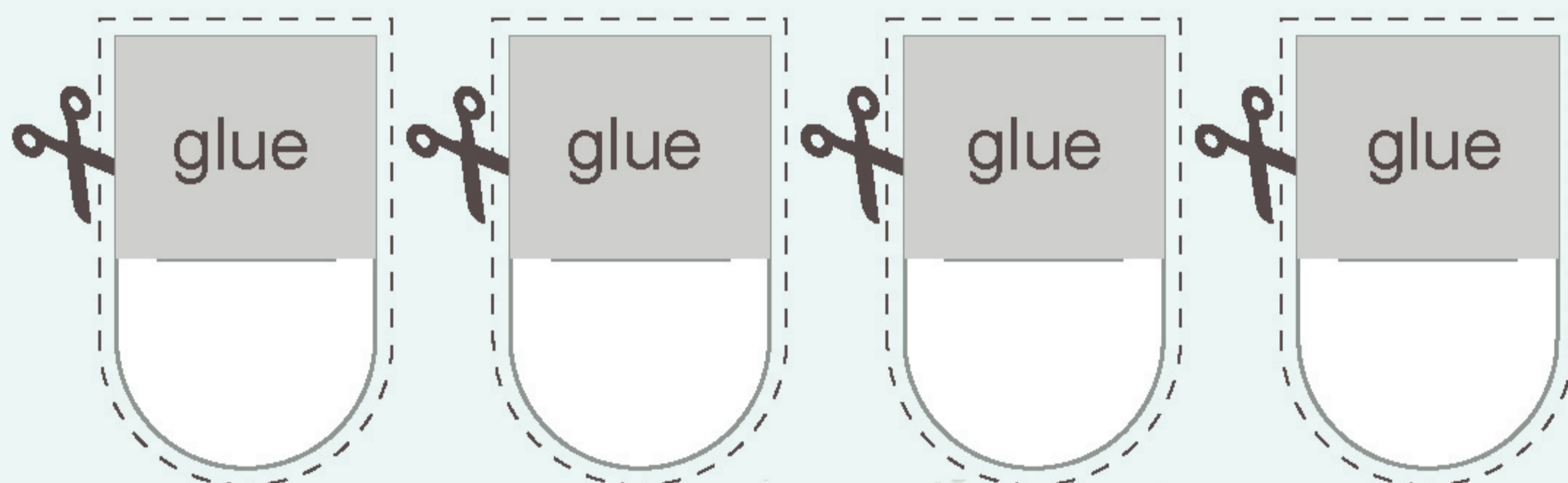
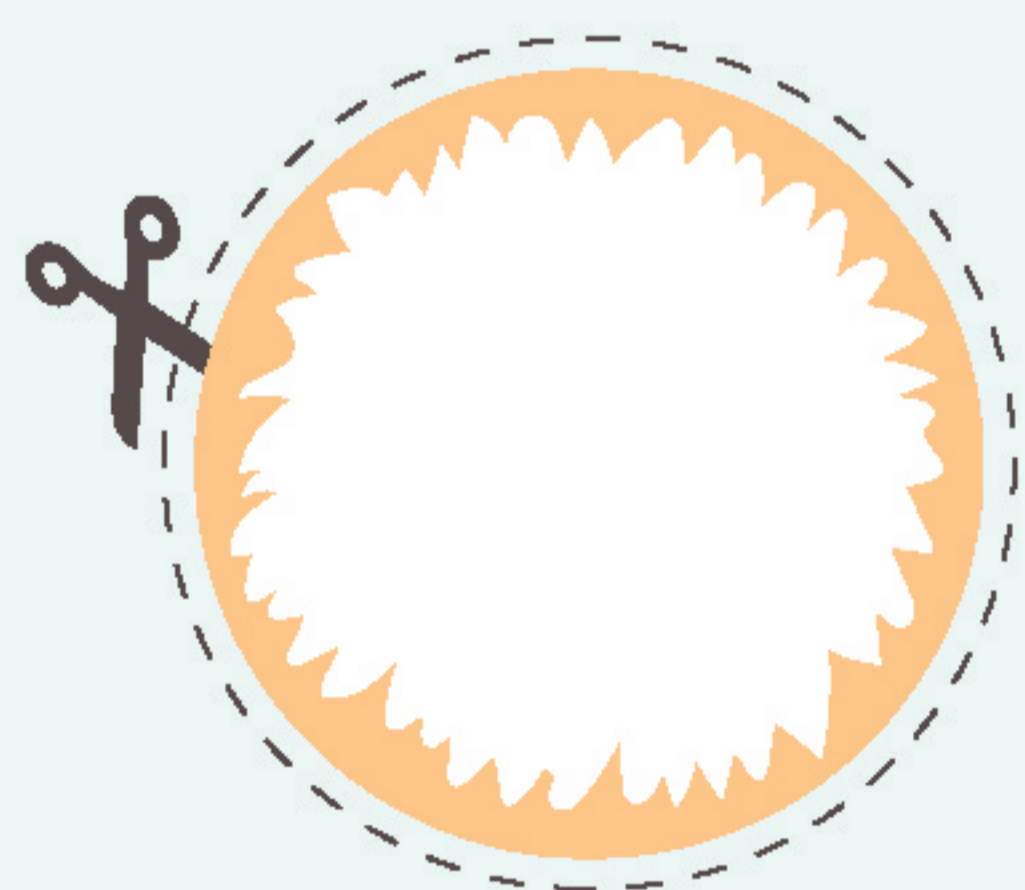
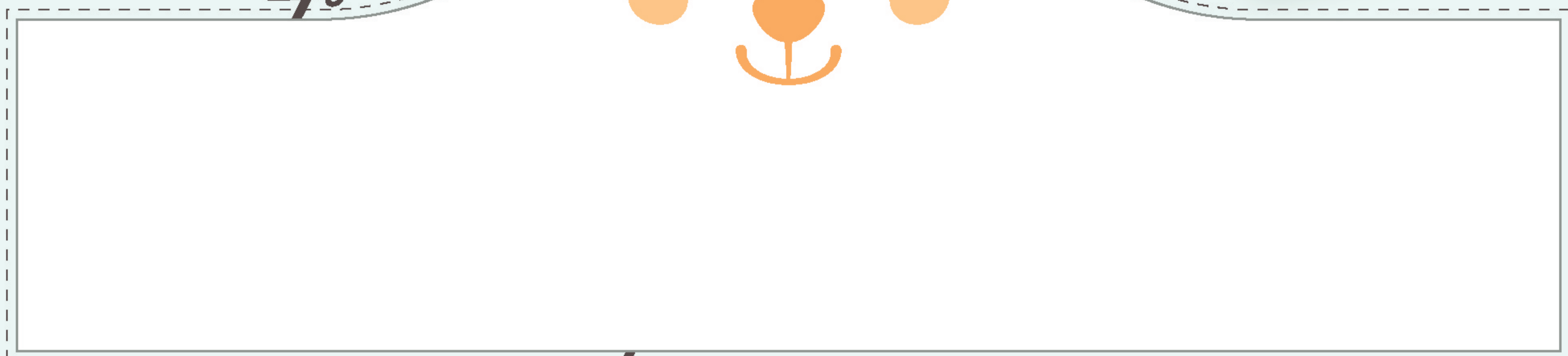

Cut Out
Body - Tail - Paws

Note for cutting the body
For the time being it is important that only the **base** is cut carefully, straight



Yes.. and now they have become very good friends!! We create a Bunny together by recycling a toilet paper roll



2 **Glue** the cut-out body around the roll, making sure that the **base** matches the base of the roll

3 **Complete the cut** finish cutting out, carefully, the **Bunny**

4 **Glue** Tail on the back of the **Bunny**

Paws Put the glue on the grey square on the front and glue the paws inside the roll, then fold them

try doing it again painting directly on cardboard ...

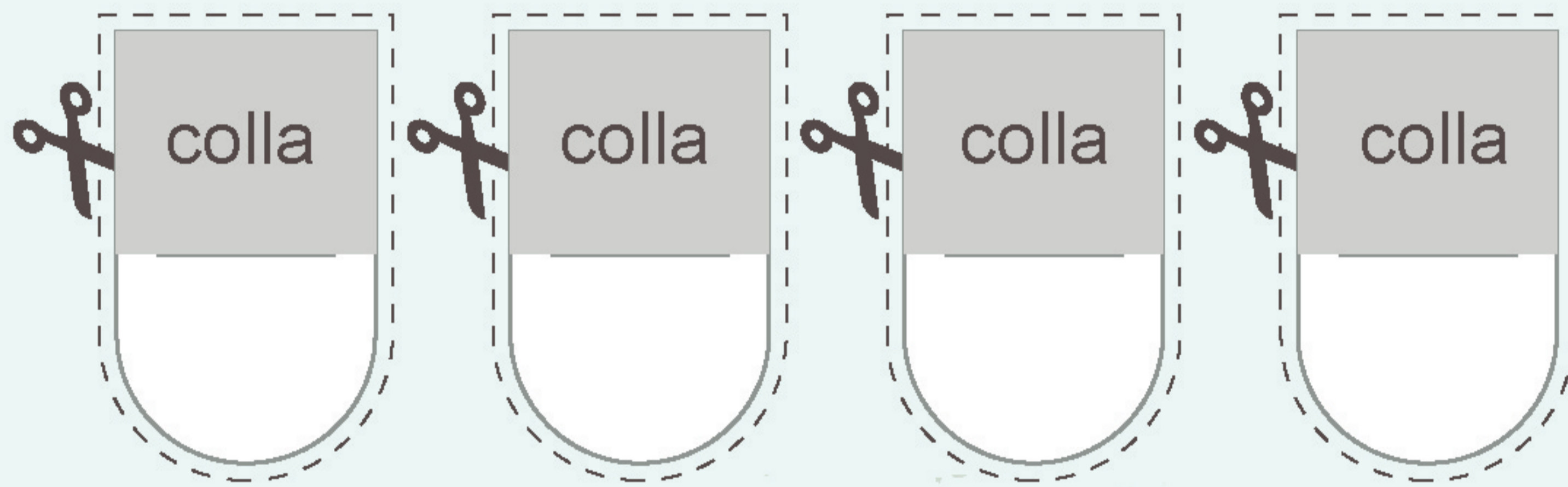
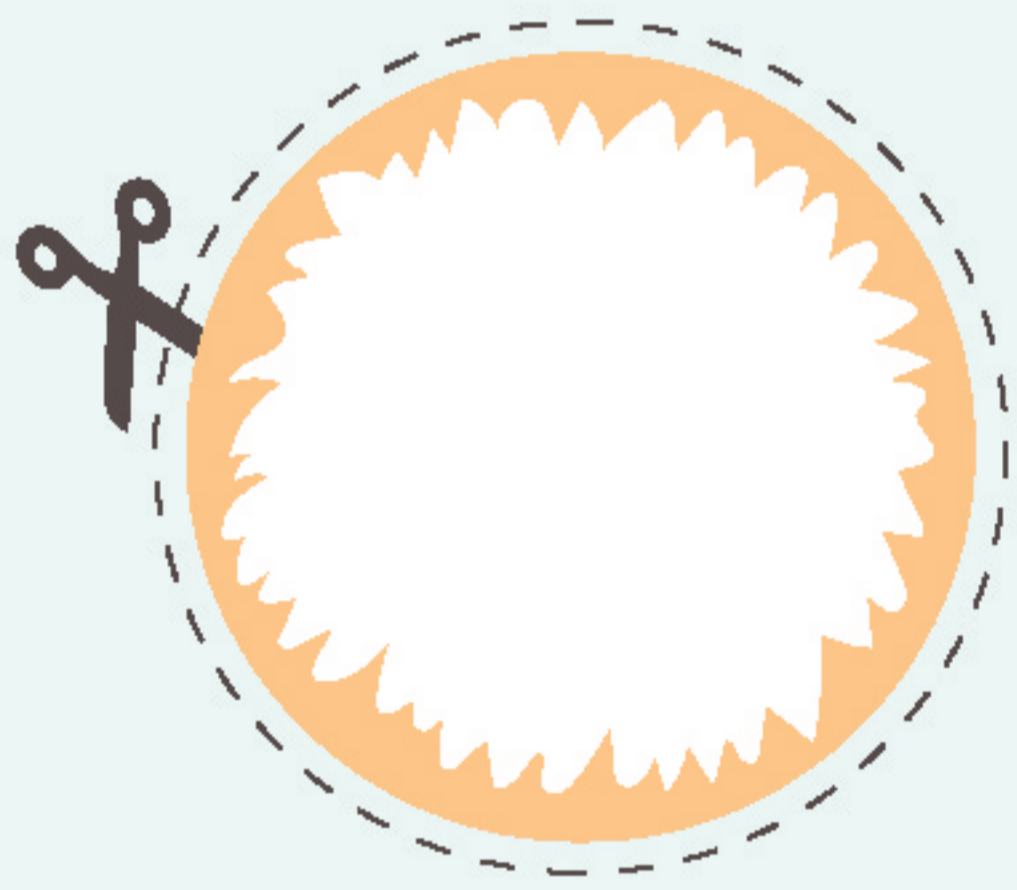

Incolla Coda sul retro del **Coniglietto**

Zampe metti la colla sul quadratino grigio sul davanti e incolla le zampe dall'interno del rotolo, poi piegale
